Volunteer

Parent and community volunteers make important contributions to our schools and enrich educational opportunities for students. Before signing up to help in a school, volunteers must complete required criminal background check forms. Additional optional training is also available.





Criminal Background Check

An approved criminal background check is required before volunteering. Interested volunteers must complete the following online form. Approved applications are valid for two years.

After completing the form, allow one to two weeks for processing. Contact your school to check your status to begin volunteering.
